

RADIANCE SURGERY CENTER ADVANCE DIRECTIVES – NOTIFICATION OF CENTER POLICY

On accordance with the Patient Self Determination Act, Radiance Surgery Center, as a provider of outpatient services, is not required to inquire about advance directives. However, to ensure the patient's right to actively participate in and direct health care decisions, if a patient presents an advance directive at the time of surgery, it will be placed in the patient's medical record, and should circumstances present which would make it appropriate, it would be honored.

Radiance Surgery Center will provide full resuscitative service for any patient requiring emergency life saving/support measures with the exception of patients who present An Advance Directive for no intervention at the time of surgery.

Advance Directives – refers to written instructions such as a living will, special power of attorney, or medical treatment plan.
