WHY DOES YOUR SURGEON USE THE KELLER FUNNEL*2?

Your doctor may choose to incorporate the funnel in your procedure for a number of reasons. One reason may be that the **KELLER FUNNEL*2** allows your surgeon to employ a "No Touch" technique, which helps reduce the risk of contamination by minimizing the amount of contact between the implant and the incision¹.

Made of a clear vinyl material with an extremely slippery coating inside, the KELLER FUNNEL™2 allows surgeons to use the device universally with silicone implants, including breast; pectoral; gluteal; and calf; and allows the surgeon to place the implant gently and with very little force.

Before surgery, talk to your doctor about the technique he or she uses to place implants with the **KELLER FUNNEL**.
